

Municipal Energy Usage & Cost for Calendar Year 2018

The City of Grapevine purchases natural gas from Atmos Energy. In calendar year 2018, the City purchased a total of 237,088 hundred cubic feet (CCF) of natural gas.

The City of Grapevine purchases electricity from Gexa Energy. In calendar year 2018, the City purchased a total of 23,560,286 kilowatt hours.

The City of Grapevine purchases electricity from CoServ Electric. In calendar year 2018, the City purchased a total of 71,766 kilowatt hours.

The City of Grapevine purchases electricity from Tri-County Electric. In calendar year 2018, the City purchased a total of 191,678 kilowatt hours.

The City of Grapevine purchases water from Trinity River Authority and is also a municipal water self-supplier. In calendar year 2018, the City purchased/consumed a total of 73,118,297 gallons of water.

The total cost for natural gas, electricity and water purchased by the City of Grapevine in calendar year 2018 is \$2,574,747.
